Dear Sir/Madam,

We bring to you Calvary greetings in Jesus' name. May the Lord strengthen and increase you in life and service amen.

I must apologize for the late communication, regarding the issues facing our Ministry, as a matter of fact, since after discussing with you in June during our visit to Nigeria. We've taken time to pray before now. We're not calling for appeal fund, but needs the free will involvement of the Church to this work of Ministry.

In view of reaching the nations of Senegal and making them disciples for our Lord, we have implored these approaches: ***Evangelism; Discipleship; Missions and Church planting; Leadership development and the Lord's House "Ker Boroom Bi" (KBB) in Wolof.***

The Lord's House, as an arm of the Ministry, will run a hostel which will serve to assist the orphans and the less privileged in the following ways: -

- Giving parental care, Education and the Gospel, to inmates.
- Running Children's Bible clubs.
- Ministering to the Quranic children, and street children.
- By Providing Health Care Service.
- Etc.

Presently, we've seven children in the home, whose official age ranges between 9yrs-19yrs. They're four girls and three boys. ***Below are their brief profiles.***

Diatta Sene: He's from a Muslim and polygamous background 16yrs old, but official school age is 14yrs. He's always sick and not academically bright. But, after he accepted Christ on the 14th January 2007 and asked for deliverance prayers, things have changed completely. He's now healthy and good looking, has passion for the lost soul and he is our first fruit and desires to be a medical doctor.

Soda Sall: She is from a Muslim background, 17yrs old but her school age is 14yrs. Her biological father gave her to a senior brother as a gift. But before she was 7, the man died, also confide her to a junior sister, through whom she came to our house since last year. She accepted Christ on the 8th April 2007 and since then been doing well in the Lord. She's our big girl in the house. She desires to be a teacher.

Lamine Faye: He's from a Muslim/Pagan family. A half orphan, but after the father's death her mother remarried but no concern for his education. He's 17yrs old, but his official age is 12yrs. His village is over 70km away from Passy, he love to be a Christian and progressively following

the pre-conversion teaching. He is in primary 5 and looks bright. And he hasn't made decision for Christ yet, though there's hope.

Fatou Ndour: She is from a Muslim background, 11yrs old and now in primary 6, though her real age is 13yrs. The transformation in the life of Soda made the parents to give her to us. She's the youngest now in the center, always timid to talk. She is one of our Bible club children from the village.

Emilie Sene: She's from the Roman Catholic Church background, a village 6km to Kaolack town. She's quiet and jovial. She is 13yrs old but official school age is 12yrs, and in primary 5. She understands the difference between the believing Christians and Roman Catholic belief, and we're trusting God for her salvation.

Ousseynou Gueye: He's from a Muslim background, parents very poor. He is 16yrs old but the official school age is 9, he is in primary 3. He attended the children bible club in the village, looks dedicated. Recently, he was not seeing in the class and when we took him to an ophthalmologist, it was discovered that the right eye can not see again due to damaged nerves, though now he's on treatment till end of January and will need glasses on the left eye in order to see. It may cost us about 120 000CFA (about 277\$) for now until the next appointment with the Doctor.

Khady Ngom: She's 19yrs old, from a Muslim background. She is our house help after the widow's departure. She has not been to school before, but desires to learn how to read and write and we're thinking of helping her to get evening lessons. She loves singing Gospel music and participates in all our fellowship meetings, though no decision yet in her few weeks with us. She enjoys all the gestures like the children in the center.

The leadership of COLOM hereby solicits for your candid partnership, prayers and financial supports to seeing the vision of "KER BOROOM BI" the Lord's house come to pass, by making the life of these precious souls see the abounding love of our Lord and savior Jesus' Christ.

We're their foster parents and are committed to augment the future generation of leaders and disciples for our king and Lord. Jesus said to the disciples *"Let the children come to me. Don't stop them! For the Kingdom of God belongs to such as these. I assure you, anyone who doesn't have their kind of faith will never get into the Kingdom of God."* Mark.10: 13-16 (NLT). We turned down some children because of the financial involvements and the accommodation we've, hence the complex construction hasn't started due to fund.

We trust that the lord will stir your heart to action as you read this piece. And your involvement in this faith mission could make a difference in their lives for the kingdom expansion.
